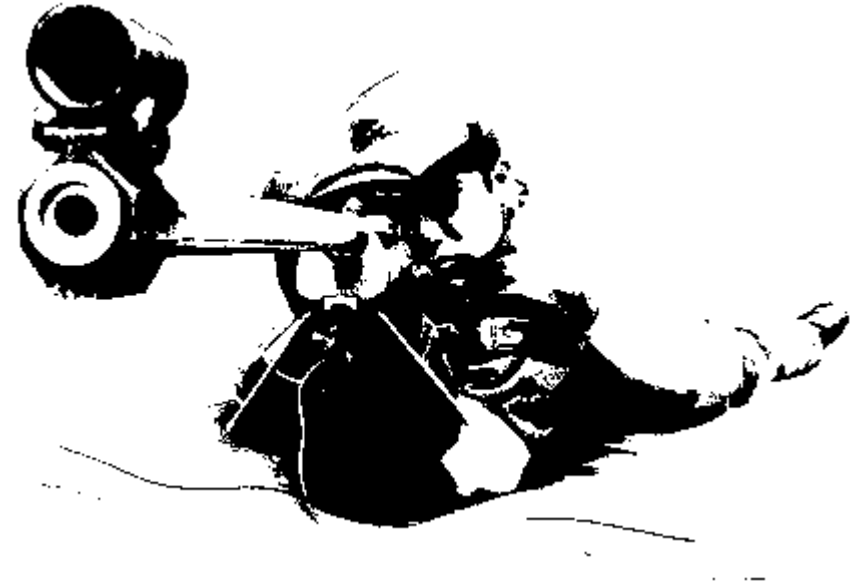

when on the firing point during the detail.
